Camp Life 2020

July 13th-July 17th

Campers must complete 5th grade (2019-2020 school year) to be eligible to attend camp.

A **\$50** deposit must be turned in with a camp application. **There are a limited numbers of spots available for camp**, in order to ensure a spot, register as early as possible.

Regular Price - \$155 (\$50 non-refundable deposit and camp registration locks in spot)

Payments can be made through cash, check, the giving kiosk, or online at lifechurchok.com. Please make checks out to *Life Church*, and **write the camper's name in the memo when writing the check.** If giving electronically, please **designate the funds to camp life and your camper's name**. Additionally, **write the last 4 digits of the card number** on the *Camp Registration Form* page on the designated line.

Lice Check: Must be done no earlier than week before leaving for camp at the Health Department. (MUST BE CLEARED TO GO)

Check-in: Monday, July 13th 10:00am CST in the Lobby at Life Church

Departure: Monday, July 13th at 2:00pm CST from Life Church

Return: Friday, July 17th at approximately 12pm CST at Life Church

The Health Department will be conducting lice checks at the health department. Any campers with a confirmed case of lice will not attend Camp Life until a signed document from the Health Department is received.

Snack Shack:

Parents can prepay for their campers to have an electronic snack shack account. The amount is up to the parents. This money will be turned into Life Church and added to an account under the camper's name. Campers will not be able to share accounts. Families with more than one camper will need to designate an amount for each **camper.** There will be no money exchanged at the snack shack. If a camper has money at camp they want to use for snacks, then that money will be turned in at the snack shack and added to their account. All campers will have an account created when the camp registration form is turned in, even if there is no money to add to their account. All transactions are based on the amount in their account. There will be no refunds of monies after camp. **Unused** funds will not be returned to the camper or family.

Further, authorization and permission is hereby given to Life Church to furnish any necessary transportation, food, lodging, and care (including medical) for this participant. The undersigned further hereby agree to hold harmless and indemnify Life Church, its directors, employees, agents, sponsors, and chaperones, for any liability sustained as the result of any negligent, willful, or intentional acts that affect my child participant and/or the undersigned.

Additionally, I grant to Life Church and persons acting for or through them the right to use, reproduce, assign, and/or distribute photographs, films, videotapes and sound recordings of said participant, for use in materials they may create.

We (I) are the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of this participant, and hereby grant our (my) permission for him/her to participate fully in said trip, and hereby give our (my) permission to take said participant to a doctor or hospital and hereby authorize medical treatment, including, but not in limitation to, emergency surgery or medical treatment, and assume the responsibility of all medical bills, if any.

If your child has prescribed medicine, please pack **only** enough medicine for the duration of the camp to decrease the risk of overdose or lost medication.

<u>All medicine</u> must be turned in to the camp nurse the day of registration in a labeled plastic bag separate from all other luggage.

Campers will not be allowed to posses medication of any kind, including over the counter drugs. The camp nurse will have general medication available such as acetaminophen, ibuprofen, etc. Legal guardians may send campers with over-the-counter drugs, but must be turned in and administered by the camp nurse.

The Health Department will be conducting lice checks at camp registration. Any campers with a confirmed case of lice will not attend Camp Life.

CAMP LIFE CASH ACCOUNT

There will be an opportunity for campers to visit the Snack Shack that is located at Camp Victory. However, we ask that no children are allowed to carry cash with them during the camp to alleviate any issues that may arise from lost or stolen money.

Parents can prepay for their kids to have an electronic snack shack account. The amount is to be determined by the discretion of the parents. This money will be turned into Life Church and added to an account under the camper's name.
